#### FESTIVAL ACCESSIBILITY

Art in the Park is a free community festival held in the beautiful heart of Leamington Spa and we're committed to making it an inclusive and welcoming space for everyone.

All of our parks are wheelchair accessible, with accessible toilets located in Jephson gardens, and an additional accessible portaloo in Mill Gardens.

For visitors with SEND needs, we've created a quiet space to retreat to if you need a moment of calm. Keep an eye out for the SEND symbol throughout

the festival - it highlights areas specifically designed with neurodivergent and sensory needs in mind.

Please note: While there are paved paths throughout the park, exhibitor stands and music stages are located on grass. If you require assistance navigating to these areas, visit our Information Tent next to the Clock Tower, or speak to one of our friendly team members in high-visibility vests - they'll be more than happy to help.

British Sign Language (BSL) interpreters will be present on both music stages, ensuring all musical performances are

accessible to our Deaf and hardof-hearing visitors.

Lost child wristbands are available at all entrance gates - please ask one of our volunteers if you'd like one for your child.

Above all, we're here to help you have a safe, joyful and inspiring day with your friends and family. If you have any additional access needs or would like to make arrangements in advance, please don't hesitate to email us at: communityofficer@artinpark.co.uk
